CONTENT REQUIREMENTS

- Articles must be supplied in Word format
- Include the author's name, affiliation/ designation, email address and a high resolution head and shoulders photo
- Length: 500 to 2000 words
- References should follow the Harvard system.

Article submissions must be original work or, where based on previously published work, the author must obtain permission from the original publisher for the work to be republished, with appropriate attribution. It is the responsibility of the author to ensure that publication of their article in Civil Engineering will not constitute a breach of any agreement or the transgression of any law, including copyright law.

IMAGE REQUIREMENTS

- High resolution (300 dpi) photographs should be supplied separately as JPGs or PNGs (size should ideally be at least 1 MB per pic). Images embedded in a Word document cannot be used.
- Graphs and figures should preferably be presented in Excel format.
- If relevant, indicate the approximate position of each photo/figure in the text.
- Supply captions for all images and figures.
- Videos can be embedded in the article. Please supply a YouTube link.

Photos, figures and diagrams must be owned by the author and not subject to copyright. In the event that an image is not owned by the author, the author must have permission from the copyright holder to use the image and attribution must be given. If the image is the author's own but has been published elsewhere, the original publisher may hold the copyright and permission may need to be obtained. Attribution without permission does not circumvent copyright.
