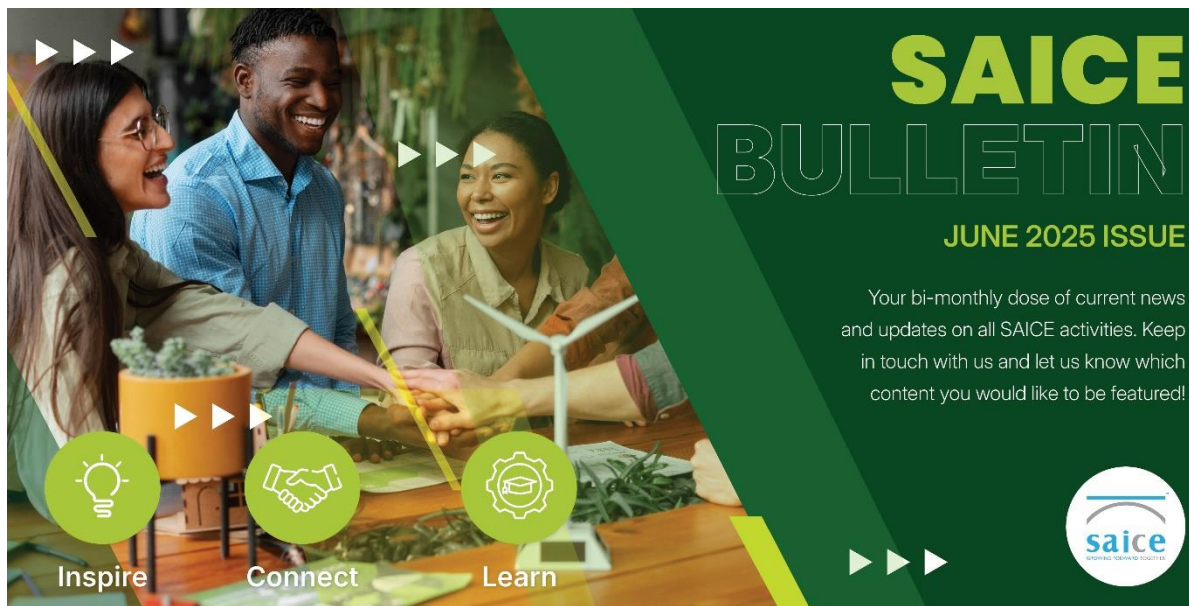

The June SAICE Bulletin - Second Edition is here!

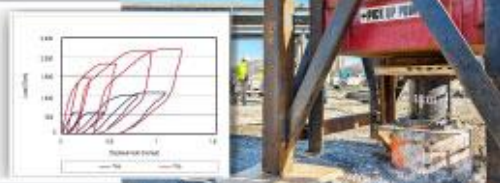

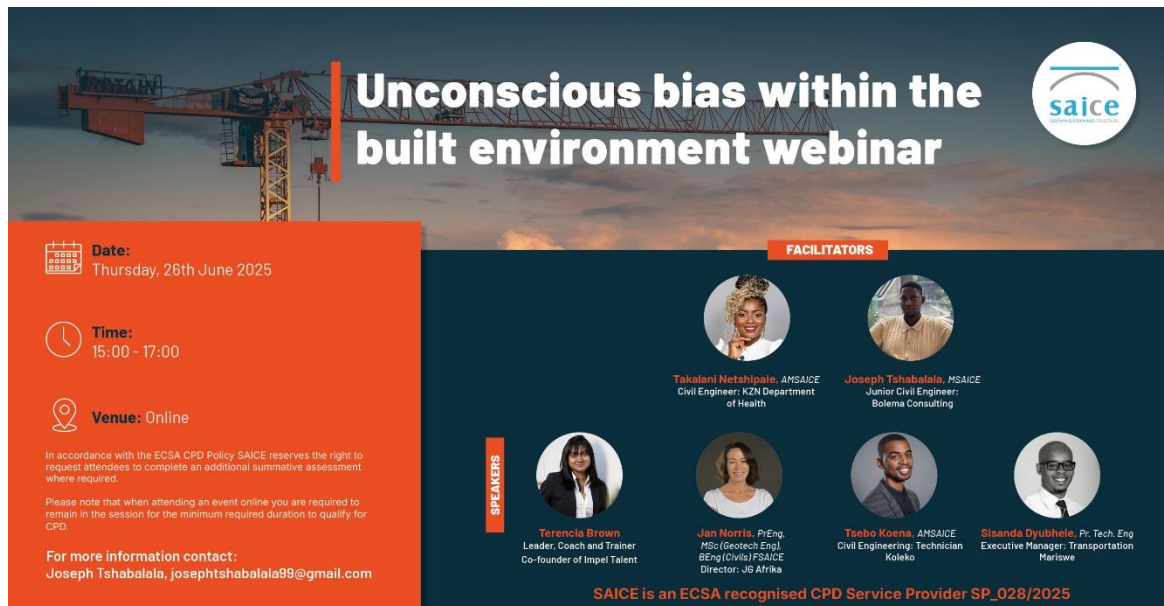

The Subcommittee consists of 9 members comprising lawyers, engineers, contract specialists, consultants and contractors, providing an equitable and balanced perspective.

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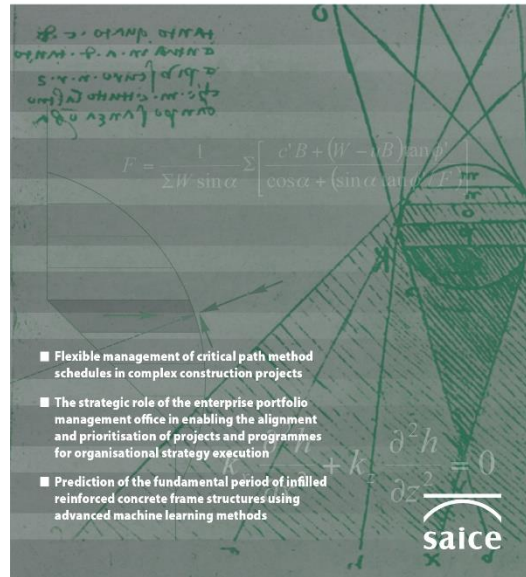
